Young Curators Club, led by a piper, leave the War Memorial and walk down to Cathedral Green, re-enacting “Evacuees”



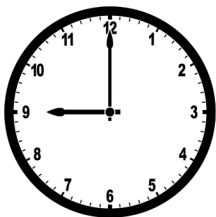
