At St. Michael and All Angels' we have a long tradition of following the Stations of the Cross during Lent, supported by the 14 beautiful plaster images from the former Scottish Episcopal Convent in Walkerburn. In the last few years, we have also followed the Stations of the Resurrection in the period between Easter and Pentecost. These are 14 meditations focused on the appearances of the risen Lord Jesus.

This year a group of 14 artists, including 3 from our own congregation, have undertaken a project to paint 14 images to accompany these Stations of the Resurrection. The paintings have been gifted by the artists to the church. They will be hung here for the first time on Easter Sunday and will remain until Pentecost. A helpful series of prayers and reflections has been created by a member of our congregation to accompany these images which will be used to walk the stations each Wednesday at 6pm from April 23rd to June 4th.

All members of the congregation and friends are invited to a reception on Thursday 24th April at 7pm to thank the artists for their generosity and to dedicate the paintings as they become part of the worship here at St. Michael and All Angels'.
