This month we enter the *Season of Creation*. If we truly believe in a God who is creator and sustainer of all that is, we also have to reconcile everything we do, each little action that may cause some harm, with the understanding that we are affecting the created order in some way.

It is a hard job being a person of faith.

Perhaps we feel this all the more when we compare our lives with those of the saints, like Gregory the Great whose feast day falls early this month – how can we possibly live up the Christian ideal – especially in our day to day lives, where it seems that the things we do to meet our basic needs contribute to chaos for the planet?

Perhaps, we think, that even today there are special people who just seem to find the Christian Life a natural fit. They get excited about church, and even sermons! They attend Bible study and spirituality groups, they work in the kitchen when the poor are fed, they subscribe to worthy causes and they already know the fine detail of the Provincial Environment Group's action plans for meeting Net Zero targets for carbon emissions.

Such an understanding (or rather, misunderstanding) actually falls short of our individual capacity to serve God. It limits our view of what **we** can do.

We are not meant to attempt the life of faith alone. Faith becomes possible when we trust God and trust each other enough to be the church. God wants to do great things through the church that

bears the cross. God wants us to see that being holy is about letting go of the worries about being judged by others and letting go of the feeling that your contribution to the church can only be so small and so it's irrelevant. Let go and hold on fast to the God who is Creator and Sustainer of all things.

Rev James Currall will be leading our Study Group for the Season of Creation (the month of September) this year it will be based around material adapted from the Season of Creation Project.

There will be four sessions each lasting a little over an hour, at Anna and James' house at 11 Ferry Road, Golspie on Wednesday afternoons at 2pm on the following dates:

- 10th Sept Ocean Depths and Delights (Job 38:1-18; Luke 5:1-11)
- 17th Sept Wisdom in the Creatures of the Earth (Job 39:1-8, 26-30; Luke 12:22-31)
- 24th Sept Good News from the Sky (Jeremiah 4:23-28; Psalm 19:1-6; Mark 15.33-39)
- 1st Oct The Wisdom Behind the World (Proverbs 8:22-31; Colossians 1:15-20)

The sessions revolve around a study of a two or three Bible passages on each occasion from the Wisdom literature in the Hebrew Bible and from the Gospels and will be semi-independent, so all are welcome even if you can't manage all of them.
